
Stars For The Linus Connection

12" block (12 1/2" unfinished) paper pieced with sashed border



This pattern was designed specifically to help create quilts for the child victims of the Central Texas fires of September 2011.



Instructions: Paper piece star units (pages 2 and 3) as desired, using a white background and colorful fabric for the star and then join the units in the following order:

B>C>D A>BCD

Square up star center to 8 1/2" (seam allowance is included in the pattern).

From sashing fabric cut:

- $2-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- $2-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 1/2" strips

Piece top and bottom sashing to star center, followed by side sashing. Finished block will be 12 1/2" (unfinished).
