

 $6'' \times 60'' \text{ ROW}$ (6 1/2" × 60 1/2" unfinished)






## Helpful Information:


- For this row, you will need 10 patterns from the following pages. The
  amount of copies to print is included on each pattern page. Mirror image
  patterns are included.
- You will need approximately 1 yard of background fabric (amount is generous to allow for different paper piecing styles).
- All other fabrics are small amounts. Use scraps or fat 1/8ths.
- To reduce bulk, use an Add-An-Eighth ruler on the grass & flowers. You can also cut a scant seam with a regular ruler.
- Chick eyes can be embroidered, appliqued, buttons, paint, etc.
- Piece each block using the sewing instructions on each page. Square up to 6 1/2" (includes seam allowance)
- After piecing and squaring up all blocks, piece row together as shown below or in the order that is most pleasing to you.
- Use a 1/4" seam to piece row.
- Row Piecing order: Grass > Chick (Mirror) > Flowers > Grass (Mirror) > Chick
   (Mirror) > Flowers > Grass > Chick > Flowers > Eggshell


